Camp Cherokee Summer Camp Covenant

Before you come to camp, please review rules and guidelines listed below which cover expectations for camp conduct. It is important that all campers understand this covenant.

- NO weapons, firearms or fireworks are allowed on Cherokee property.
- Campers are not permitted in any of the cabins or sleeping units of the opposite sex.
- No one is to leave the lodge or cabin area by him or herself.
- Respect the property of Camp Cherokee. NO GRAFFITI.

All campers are to understand that if a camper does not abide by these guidelines, they will be sent home at the expense of the campers' parent/guardian or their local church.
